If you haven't already uploaded your images, stop here and learn how to Create Featured Images with Canva. Remember, your images will need to be compliant with Facebook Advertising Policies.

Go to rule number 4 Set featured images, click Choose random images.

If you haven't done so already, you have to upload a group of images that could be used. That should be generic enough to work with almost any blog post. Should be at least 600 x 315 pixels. For the WordPress SuperBlog, we do recommend 740 x 390 pixels for the image size because it would look great on the blog and on Facebook.

To select multiple images, hold down CTRLkey and click on the image.
